Peter Hemings in the "art of  
French cookery." Other cooks  
at Monticello were Edith (Edy)  
Hern Fossett, Francis (Fanny)  
Gillette Hern, Ursula (Isaac  
Jefferson's mother), Suck (Jupiter's  
wife), and Lucy Gillette.  
The individual heat supplies for  
the pots was a concept brought  
back from France.*
